What data we process

In reference to your participation in the event as a Proponent, Speaker or Scientific Referent, we need to know the following personal data about you:

First and last name, date of birth, tax code or VAT number, country of origin, residence, contact details, educational qualification, scientific knowledge, bank details.

Purpose of the Policy

We process these data exclusively for organizational, administrative and accounting management purposes related to the event, i.e., to register you in our databases, to invoice you for your contribution or a reimbursement of expenses if applicable, and to promote your event. In this regard, we would like to inform you that during events, professionals authorized by us take photographs that are published on our website and included in printed brochures and other promotional materials.

Timing of retention

We will retain your contribution data in our accounting databases (computerized and paper) for the period mandated by tax and accounting regulations, after which, it will be irreversibly deleted.

The name and record of your event will be placed in the event archive and retained for the time of the Association's duration.

Who may know your data

In addition to the Public Administrations and Control Bodies to which we have to communicate your data in order to fulfill a legal obligation, the following categories of recipients may know your personal data: banks; companies and professionals who provide us with services and advice in accounting, tax and legal matters; individuals to whom we have entrusted the technical management of the computer system (in case of incidents and the need for system changes and control).

Employees and collaborators who, by reason of their duties, process your personal data are adequately trained and specially authorized to do so.

Your Rights

At any time you may access your data to enforce the following rights:

- obtain confirmation of the existence of the data and have them available in readable form within one month of the request;
- request their rectification or integration;
- obtain information about the current processing;
- restrict or object to the processing in certain cases;
- obtain deletion of data, e.g., if the purpose of processing ceases or if processing is unlawful;



- withdraw consent;
- obtain in a portable, commonly used, and machine-readable format the data provided directly in computer and processed by automated means and transmit them to another Data Controller;
- know whether your data are processed by automated means and demand that automated decisions, including profiling, without human intervention are not made with respect to you.

In addition, you can file a complaint with the supervisory authority in case of violation of your rights

How to exercise your rights

You can exercise your rights by contacting us at privacy@festivalscienza.it. We will make every effort to respond to you within 30 days of receiving your request.

Limitations on the exercise of your rights

We would like to inform you that there are limitations to the exercise of your rights, for example, when actual and concrete prejudice may result from the exercise of them:

- to the rights and freedoms of others;
- for the conduct of defensive investigations and the exercise of a right in court;
- for the confidentiality of the identity of the employee who reports pursuant to Law No. 179 of November 30, 2017, the wrongdoing of which he/she has become aware by reason of his/her office.
- for the interests protected by anti-money laundering regulations;
- for the interests protected by the legislation on support for victims of extortion demands;
- for other reasons of public interest, for example, national defense, public security, monetary policy, crime prevention etc.

In the presence of any of the above hypotheses, we will send you a reasoned communication without delay, unless the aforementioned communication would jeopardize the very reason for the restriction. In any case You have the right to file a complaint with the Guarantor pursuant to Article 77 of the Regulations.
